Application Process

1. Attend one of the optional Honors Explorations informational sessions:

Wednesday, October 31 at 12 p.m. in SCHAR 2008
 2. Complete the online application (available by October 30) by Monday, November 26 at 12 p.m. (noon).
 3. The selection committees will make decisions by the end of the Fall 2018 semester.
Selected students will be notified on or before December 18.
