Study Abroad

Students can fulfill Honors Cultural Visions requirements by studying abroad. The Honors College uses the study abroad experience, not the specific courses, to fulfill the requirements. It does not matter which subjects students study while abroad (e.g., art, history, economics, business, language, religion, science, etc.); the experience of studying abroad fulfills 1-2 Honors Cultural Visions requirements. - Approved TCU or "Partner Program" **summer** study abroad program = ONE Honors Cultural Visions
- **Honors Abroad** experience (e.g., Cultural Routes, Cultural Pathways, Cultural Pilgrimages, etc.) = ONE Honors Cultural Visions
- Approved TCU or "Partner Program" **fall** or **spring** study abroad program = TWO Honors Cultural Visions
