## Academic Credit

Students who participate in an Honors Explorations program satisfy **one** Cultural Visions competency requirement in the John V. Roach Honors College curriculum. Please note that, because you do not enroll in a course, you do not pay TCU tuition. However, this also means that *you do not receive hours toward graduation.*

## Application Process

1. Attend one of the Honors Explorations informational sessions:  
**Wednesday, October 18 at 4 p.m. in RJH 215 or Thursday, October 19 at 4 p.m. in SCHAR 1010**  
Attendance at an information session is not required to be eligible to apply.
2. Complete the online application (available by October 30) by Monday, November 27 at 12 p.m. (noon).\*
3. The selection committees will make decisions by the end of the Fall 2017 semester. Selected students will be notified on or before December 19.
4. \$1000 deposit due by Monday, January 22, 2018.

## Program Fees: \$2500-\$4500
