

TCU Core Curriculum

Students need a range of 39-63 credit hours to complete the TCU Core Curriculum. (You may "double dip" up to 24 credit hours.)

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| <p>In the HMVV curriculum, you may take a maximum of two courses from any one subject area as defined by course prefix (e.g., the course prefix for Economics is ECON).
